Greek Community Standards**

**Adopted April 1, 1992
Revised February, 1995**

The following expectations were developed by the Greek Community to enhance the Greek experience. The purpose of these statements is to enrich Greek, campus and community relations. The Greek Community Standards were developed as part of the 1991 Greek Strategic Plans.

1. At all times, respect the property of others, as well as your own,
2. Respect the human dignity of others: sexual, verbal and physical abuse or any type of hazing is unacceptable.
3. Respect individual differences,
4. Strive to obtain a high level of academic integrity.
5. Excessive abuse or illegal use of alcohol will not be tolerated; including underage drinking or illegal distribution.
6. The use if illegal drugs will not be tolerated.
7. Observe the Good Neighbor Policy in the Greek Community and Tucson Community.
8. Support the Tucson Community through social service.

When it is alleged that the organization, its officers or its individual members have failed to comply with the obligations set forth under the Greek Community Standards, the Greek Community may follow established Greek Judicial Board policies and procedures to conduct an investigation and render sanctions.
