

**Panhellenic Association, National Pan-Hellenic Council, Interfraternity Council**  
**At the University of Arizona**  
**Resolution of Sexual Assault**  
**Adopted April, 1986**  
**Revised February, 1995**

WHEREAS, The Interfraternity Council, the National Pan-Hellenic Council, and the Panhellenic Association at the University of Arizona and its members are concerned about the increasing incidents of rape, sexual assault, date rape and other violent crimes against women and men on college campuses, and,

WHEREAS, It is recognized that approximately twenty percent of women on college campuses have been victims of rape or attempted rape, and,

WHEREAS, It is known that date acquaintance rape and sexual assault often result from inadequate communication between parties concerning expectations and sexual limits and often involves the use of alcohol and/or drugs

LET IT THEREFORE BE RESOLVED by the Interfraternity Council, the National Pan-Hellenic Council, and the Panhellenic Association that the following policies be adopted and be recommended to its member chapters for their adoption:

1. That we will educate our current members and all new members or associate members on issues of sexual assault by implementing a rape prevention program within each chapter.
2. That we will provide easily accessible channels of communication via literature, professional assistance, and support groups for those of our members who are inquiring about issues of sexual assault.
3. That we will encourage members to plan social functions and choose themes that condone an atmosphere that will represent positive and respectable roles of men and women within our community.
4. That we will preserve and protect the rights and safety of all individuals in all social settings- especially those during which alcohol is served.
5. That we will promptly and honestly address incidents of sexual misconduct (sexual assault) and if necessary refer our members to the proper authorities.
